Lesson Objectives:

At the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- 1. Understand how to form the near future tense
- 2. Using the near future tense to make plans for the future
- 3. Answer questions based on the content

STEP 1: The facilitator will explain to the students that when forming the near future tense, you will use the verbs ir (conjugated) in the present tense +a (to)+ and infinitive (a verb that is not conjugated).

The Spanish verb IR (to go) is one of the most commonly used verbs in Spanish. It can be used for everything from announcing where you are going to what you are going to do. The verb Ir happens to be a highly irregular verb.

IR to go.

Yo	voy
Tú	Vas
usted (Ud.), él, ella	Va
Nosotros/as	Vamos
Uds	Van

STEP 2: The facilitator will guide the students in asking questions and responding using the near future tense.

- ¿Qué vas a comer mañana?
 Mañana voy a comer pizza.
- ¿Qué van a hacer el lunes?
 El lunes vamos a estudiar.
- ¿Qué vas a estudiar hoy?
 Hoy voy a estudiar el inglés.
