MODE OF STUDY: HOW YOU STUDY AT AIM-USA

Stage 1 of the University Pathway is for BTEC Level 5 Diploma which is taught directly by AIM-USA's Institute (The Colbourne College, Jamaica).

From anywhere in the world that you live, you can join our classes that are held 100% live Online or In-Class in Kingston, Jamaica. Distant learning is also available, where students manage their own study time and flexible schedule, under the guidance of a Faculty Supervisor.

Attend Classes On-Campus (Full-Time / Part-Time)

Learners attend classes on-campus in Jamaica and online. This is called blended mode.

Study Online From Anywhere

Online Learners will attend scheduled and live classes online. You see, hear and engage with your peers and instructors. You do group work and participate in some extra-curricular activities. You can attend classes from anywhere in the world that you live and earn the same globally recognized UK And US qualification as the students who are studying on-campus. You also attend the same graduation ceremony. If you start the Diploma online, you can transfer to on-campus at the start of any new semester.

Study Distant Learning

Distant Learners do not attend scheduled classes but meet the same learning and assessment requirements as On-campus And Online learners. You also attend the graduation ceremony. If you start the Diploma online, you can transfer to on-campus for the degree study-work years abroad. If you start the Diploma online, you can transfer to on-campus at the start of any new semester.

Learner Services

On-campus, Online And Distant Learners have access to the same lesson notes, group discussion forums, student community groups, and Faculty Advisors. The main difference being how they choose to attend classes or learn. On-campus and online learners may participate in student government, represent the college at international and national levels, and have direct access to the instructors for each unit.
